Notes:

- Scholarship applications must be received by EFS at least two months prior to the event to which the scholarship will be applied.
- Each individual may be awarded a maximum of one scholarship per calendar year.
- The applicant must be a current member of EFS, and must have been an EFS member for at least six months.
- Currently fifteen \$50 dollar scholarships are available per calendar year.
- EFS will not fund greater than 100% of any event, e.g. if the workshop costs \$35, we will give a scholarship no greater than \$35.
- Scholarship recipients are expected to give volunteer time back to EFS. This can be done by performing volunteer work for EFS, serving on the EFS board, serving on an EFS related committee, and other similar activities.
- Please contact the EFS Coordinator regarding the status of your application.
- These scholarships are separate from the work scholarships awarded by the committee of the EFS Cascade Contras Dance and Music Weekend.
- Scholarship awards are at the discretion of the EFS board of directors, and all decisions are final.
